MAIZE DRILLING COURSE – UPDATE

Consistent seed placement at drilling is one of the most important steps down the road towards a great crop of maize. It is with top quality drilling in mind that with the help of Rod and David from Bright Seeds, the MGA

are running three Maize Drilling Courses during March next year. The courses will be very practical, being focused around a real-life maize drill and run by Simon Draper, MGA Agronomist.

Objectives

- Improve understanding of why precision seed and fertiliser spacing within the row and seed and fertiliser depth are particularly important to maize.
- Improve understanding of what makes a good maize seedbed
- Better understand the cultivation options available to make a good maize seedbed
- Improve understanding of the need or lack of need for starter fertiliser.

Plan of action

- 1. To run a 3 hour morning course based at local agricultural colleges to consist of
 - Arrival at 9.30 for coffee/registration
 - Classroom presentation given by MGA representative setting out the importance of top quality drilling to include:
 - Seed spacing
 - Seed depth
 - Target seedbed conditions
 - Use of starter fertiliser
 - Practical field or workshop session with engineer talking and demonstrating drill set up.
- 2. Produce paper and video support material that will be made available to all members via normal MGA Knowledge transfer routes.
